Students must be currently enrolled in a French language course. Eligible students will have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement. The Education Committee of the Alliance Française of Hawai'i will select recipients. Internship recipients will be expected to provide a minimum of three to four hours of service per month to promote the mission of the Alliance Française of Hawai'i.
